

Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Sciences and Engineering

2018/2nd edition

In order to encourage and acknowledge the work of Spanish researchers in the field of sciences and engineering*, the Banco Sabadell Foundation announces the call for the second Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Sciences and Engineering 2018.

The award consists of a cash prize of 50,000 euros.

Terms and conditions 2018

1 The award will be given to a researcher with an outstanding curriculum in the field of research into sciences and engineering.*

2 Candidates must meet the following requisites: be researchers who were under the age of 43 on 1st January 2018, who have spent at least three years engaging in research activities in Spain, and who have focused their research on the field of sciences and engineering.

3 Candidates must be put forward by persons with links to universities or research centres.

4 Proposals must be submitted, in Spanish or English, between 5 March 2018 and 30 April 2018 (both inclusive), online using the webpage <https://www.fundacionbancosabadell.com/en/> (Grants & Awards/Prizes section).

5 Each proposal must be formed of:
— A letter of introduction from the person putting forward the candidate, in PDF format. This letter must give a brief summary (1-2 pages) of the candidate's contributions.
— The candidate's CV (preferably no longer than 20 pages), in PDF format.
— Documentation corresponding to the primary research works carried out by the candidate (maximum of 10 papers or projects), in PDF format.

6 The jury, chaired by Professor Andreu Mas-Colell, Chairman of BIST, is formed by: Prof. Rosa M. Badia, Prof. Isabel Cacho Lascorz, Prof. Antonio M. Echavarren, Prof. Javier Fernández de Bobadilla, Prof. Juan Fuster Verdú, Prof. María Angeles Gil Álvarez, Prof. José Manuel González, Prof. Lluís Jofre i Roca, Prof. Anna Sanpera Trigueros, Prof. María Vallet Regí. The jury's decision, which is not open to appeal, will be published in July 2018. The winner of the award must be present at the official award ceremony and at the announcement of the award to the media (lunch with members of the press and representatives of the jury).

7 The submission of applications entails the full acceptance of all of these terms and conditions.
