

DESIGN AWARD ANFACO/ BANCO SABADELL FOUNDATION 2018–1ST EDITION



It is a competition organised by ANFACO CECOPESCA and Banco Sabadell Foundation, with the aim of selecting young designers to design the commemorative plaque to celebrate 115 years of ANFACO-CECOPESCA, under the claim “CATA LA LATA” which will then be displayed at the ANFACO museum in 2019.

This initiative aims to recognise and develop the creative talent of young designers, and give them the opportunity to showcase their work. Furthermore, the competition aims to promote the inclusion of these designs in relevant products.

Designers who can participate

Designers of any nationality can participate, yet they must have studied at a Spanish design school, be under thirty five, and comply with the requirements set forth herein.

Panel of judges

The panel of judges has been agreed upon by ANFACO, and Banco Sabadell Foundation. The panel shall select the ten finalists and the winner. The panel of judges shall meet in January 2019. Each judge shall be entitled to vote and the majority vote shall rule.

Exhibition

The exhibition shall be given the title ANFACO-Banco Sabadell Foundation Design Award, and it shall be composed of the design proposals submitted by the ten finalists selected by the panel of judges. The exhibition will be held at the ANFACO Museum during 2019.

Catalogue

A catalogue dedicated to the ten finalist designers shall be created.

Competition and Exhibition

The competition and the exhibition shall be governed as follows:

1. Prior entry of candidate

- 1.1. Designers of any nationality can participate, yet they must have studied design at a Spanish design school, and they must be under thirty five.
- 1.2. Designers who wish to participate in the competition must submit their entry to the Banco Sabadell Foundation: www.fundacionbancosabadell.com/convocatorias between October 1st and December 14th, both inclusive, submitting:
 - Their design proposal (pdf format, size A1 59.4 x 81.1 cm).
 - A biographical note or CV (two page maximum), explaining their most relevant achievements in their career.
 - Personal details, address, telephone contact email and a copy of their National I.D. number (DNI) or passport.
 - Statement declaring that the works selected for the exhibition have not been selected for any other competitions.

2. Selection of participants

- 2.1. Amongst the participants, a panel of judges (formed as explained in these terms and conditions) will select the ten finalists, and then the winner, who will be sent 6,000 euros in prize value via a bank transfer.
- 2.2. The results of this selection process will be published before 31 January 2019.
- 2.3. Based on the quality of the works submitted, the panel of judges may select less than ten finalists or declare the competition to be null.
- 2.4. Designers who have participated commit to be reachable by telephone or email to receive notification of the decision made by the panel of judges, and if they are selected, to provide any information which is required from them.

3. Submission of proposals

- 3.1. Between October 1st and December 14th 2018 (both inclusive).
- 3.2. The submission of creative proposals implies the free assignment of reproduction rights in favour of ANFACO, and ANFACO reserves the production and usage rights of the ten finalist designs.
- 3.3. ANFACO and Banco Sabadell Foundation reserve the right to diffuse the creative works of the ten finalists through their official channels.

4. Exhibition of designs

- 4.1. The exhibition will be held at the ANFACO Museum in 2019 and it may be shown State-wide.
- 4.2. A catalogue will be created, including some of the proposals submitted and the ten finalist designs.

5. Personal data processing

The personal data of the candidates shall be processed by ANFACO-CECOPESCA as the party responsible for the processing, whereby such data is necessary for the management and handling of the award, as well as for subsequent publicity and diffusion of the same. The personal data shall be conserved for as long as necessary for the management and diffusion of the award for the period indicated in these terms and conditions. Banco Sabadell Foundation, as the party responsible for the processing, shall capture the personal data provided in the form published on its website, on behalf and in representation of ANFACO-CECOPESCA.

The interested party may, under the terms set forth in data protection regulations, exercise their rights to access, rectify, oppose, suppress, limit and portability, by writing to the registered address of the party responsible for the data processing ANFACO – CECOPESCA, or through the following email address: anfaco@anfaco.es. Furthermore, in the event that the interested party deems it to be necessary, they may contact the Spanish Data Protection Agency (AEPD for its acronym in Spanish) for the purpose of safeguarding their rights.
