

Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Economic Research

2024/23rd edition

Banco Sabadell Foundation, with the aim of incentivising and acknowledging the work of Spanish researchers in the field of economic, business and social research, and contribution to the analysis and development of methods which promote social welfare, is opening the call for the XXIII edition of the Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Economic Research.

The award is worth 30,000 euros.

Terms and conditions of the call

- 1** The award shall be granted to a researcher aged up to 40, who has an outstanding research curriculum in the fields indicated above.
- 2** Candidates must be recommended by researchers, universities, academic and research centres, foundations, companies and other institutions, national as well as international.
- 3** Candidates must meet all of the following requirements:
 - Be a researcher of Spanish nationality, aged up to 40, as at 31 December 2023. This age requirement can be increased by up to one year per child when there have been career breaks due to leave for childbirth and childcare. Where applicable, candidates should provide sufficient evidence of that circumstance at the request of the Banco Sabadell Foundation.
 - The candidate must have based their research on the topics described above.
- 4** The proposals must be prepared in Spanish or in English between 15 February 2024 and 1 April 2024 (both inclusive), online via the website <https://www.fundacionbancosabadell.com> (Activity section, Awards). Each proposal should also be supplemented with the candidate's curriculum and as many complementary documents as deemed necessary.
- 5** The panel of judges shall be chaired by Mrs. Teresa Garcia-Milà, Professor at Universitat Pompeu Fabra and Director of The Barcelona School of Economics. The members of the jury will be appointed by the Foundation from among persons of recognized competence. The judges' verdict is final, and it shall be made public from September 2024. The award winner shall attend the award ceremony. The prize money (30,000 euros) will be deposited on the date the Award Ceremony takes place by bank transfer to the account the researcher holds at Banco Sabadell.
- 6** To prepare for the eventuality that the candidate receives an award, they hereby assign to the Banco Sabadell Foundation the right to use their own image and voice, free of charge, to the maximum extent permitted by law, so that the Foundation may broadcast, among other things, the award ceremony and report its result. This assignment will be formalised prior to the award ceremony.
